

Historical Accommodations: Villa Principe Leopoldo



From the time it was built by the Berlin architects Clemens and Könitz for the cavalry general Fredrick Leopold Von Hohenzollern, a Prussian prince, in the year 1926, Villa Principe Leopoldo has always been the stage of many important historical events and the crossroads of illustrious destinies.

The historical residence, with its typical architecture, inspired by local Heimatstil, dominates the lake of Lugano from the Canton of Ticino's most magical spot, the fabulous "Collina d'Oro", offering breath-taking views on the spectacular surrounding: the mountain ranges, the transparent lake and sky, the seasonal changing colours of the nearby woods and the city's thousand lights. DESCRIPTION/ GENERAL OVERVIEW

Villa Principe Leopoldo offers the very best in terms of discretion and luxury. In the area in front of the semi-circular hotel building, one already senses the princely atmosphere of years gone by. It was, in fact, Prince Leopold himself, who had the palace built in 1926 in the typical architecture inspired by the local Heimatstil, which still gives it its look today. The semi-circular shape of its layout becomes the leit-motif of the whole structure and it's to be found everywhere, even in the Villa's exterior and in the two pavilions that delimit the vast hanging gardens on the terrace, made even more beautiful by the octagonal fountain at the centre, which reminds us of other renowned historical buildings, such as the magnificent Castel Del Monte. Whether one decides to stay to simply relax or to celebrate in private or with numerous guests or for important business meetings, our guests will always be able to take advantage of the precious assistance of our staff in a peaceful, exclusive and elegant milieu. One of the pillars on which the success of the hotel has been built is its award-winning cuisine - simple, pure genuine and respectful of tradition- may very rightfully be termed "worthy of a prince". Furthermore, guests may dedicate time and relax to themselves in the intimate atmosphere of the Private Spa, where personalised top-quality treatments await them. RESTAURANTS & BAR

Today, delicious snacks are also served here. Those guests wishing to make the moment even more perfect by smoking a cigar, may go to the Principe Bar Lounge, which is reserved for smokers only and which is located inside one of the two glass pavilions that embrace the vast hanging gardens on the terrace. In summer, a part of the Restaurant is transferred to the pavilion just opposite, which is also semi-

circular, so as to not interrupt the harmony of the structure's rounded curves. There is nothing more enchanting than a lunch or a romantic dinner, caressed by a soft summer breeze against a backdrop of mountains embracing the lake as if it were an arena, while the deep blue water reflects its image and speckling lights against the dusk of beautiful Lugano resting on its shore. In those instants, the surrounding world becomes an unforgettable spectacle and a triumph of nature.

PRIVATE DOT SPA

In the small but sophisticated DOT Spa, one is personally taken care of. Exclusive international cosmetic lines are the true protagonists of all face and body treatments and also of the Spa's massages. Equipped with sauna, Hamman, hydro massage and relax zone, it represents a unique solution to complete a romantic and unforgettable stay.

CONFERENCE ROOMS

The hotel's six conference rooms may host up to 250 people. The whole of the hotel's first floor may be destined to welcoming (on the basis of requirements) from small business meeting, to medium size banquets up to large conferences and all other sorts of events. From the Billiard Room, the smallest room, structured almost like a privè, which can contain up to about ten people, one passes to the Montalbano Hall, exceptional for cocktail parties for about150 guests. The Montalbano Room, if joined to the Melograno room may hold up to 220 guests. Besides the usual equipment, the conference rooms may be fitted out with simultaneous interpretation booths. Several different programmes to support team building may be organised. All conference rooms are well lit, by natural light and some of them have a wonderful panoramic

view onto the Lake and the city of Lugano. Internet access is free in all the common spaces of the hotel, conference rooms and bedrooms, thanks to the attribution of W-LAN codes.

LEISURE TIME & SPORT

The Villa Principe Leopoldo hotel's leisure time offer may be easily integrated with a visit to Lugano's city centre. The hotel will see to organising a shuttle bus to and from the city. Famous for being the third Swiss financial market and for guaranteeing exclusive shopping opportunities in its historical centre, Lugano is considered the jewel of Ticino. The inauguration of LAC (Lugano, Art and Culture) the new international cultural hub, which will take place in September, is a further opportunity for the city to gain a more contemporary façade and assume the role of being the real protagonist of Italian Switzerland.

There are also many walks and excursions in the surroundings and some of these depart at the hotel's very threshold, like the interesting Hermann Hesse path that starts at Gentilino, at only ten minutes from the villa, in front of the post office. Along the way one encounters signs with some of the writer's words, which comment and accompany the walk in a very suggestive and pertinent way. The itinerary ends at the museum dedicated to Hermann Hesse in Montagnola.

Golf players will be tempted by the greens of the most ancient golf course of southern Switzerland. A ten minute car ride separates the hotel from this historical golf course founded in 1923 and which holds in store a perfect golfing experience: 5.657 metres and 18 holes of happiness in the midst of century old trees like birches, oaks and umbrella pines. In springtime, the golf course becomes colourful with blooming rhododendrons and azaleas and nature smiling on. The course's level of difficulty is moreover considered high on account of the many water obstacles and rather narrow fairways that characterise it. At about one hour away, 20 other Ticinese and Lombard golf courses may be reached. Milan, the capital of fashion, may be reached in about 60 minutes by car. Organising a trip there is very easy and an adventure in nearby Italy is always an enjoyable surprise. In case of bad weather, a visit to the nearby Fox Town Outlet Centre in Mendrisio always guarantees a fun shopping experience, while families can amuse themselves at the enormous Splash & Spa aquatic park, a structure at the feet of Mount Tamaro, where both adults and

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children can have great fun first in the huge swimming pools with breathtaking slides and then relaxing in the Spa area.
